



What is SASC?

The SpLD Assessment Standards Committee (SASC) is a representative organisation for professionally qualified diagnostic assessors of specific learning difficulties (SpLD). SASC members work to agreed standards of practice, established collaboratively by the organisation.

SASC was first established in 2005 when a working group comprising SpLD practitioners and Department for Education representatives met to consider what would constitute acceptable evidence of SpLD for a student to qualify for the Disabled Students' Allowance (DSA). Since 2005 SASC has extended its remit to become an advisory and regulatory body for practitioner assessors of SpLD.

SASC's work involves key elements which are to:

- propose standards and a code of practice for all those involved in assessments, including the production of reports in an agreed and accessible format.
- maintain a publicly accessible list of qualified assessors.
- identify a selection of tests that can be used by appropriately trained and qualified professionals, alongside guidelines for practice and training.
- support the implementation of updated guidance around the assessment of SpLDs, providing advice about identifying, assessing and referring students with any of the



SASC provides guidance in order to promote good practice in the psychological assessment of children and adults. Individuals with neurodiverse profiles or specific learning difficulties such as dyslexia, dyspraxia, dyscalculia, ADD/ADHD and ASD can benefit from an effective assessment which is rigorous, comprehensive and appropriate.

SASC provides guidance for SpLD assessors on the use of appropriate tests and the careful interpretation of assessment test results. See the links on the right-hand side for further information.

Assessment Practising Certificate


Specialist teachers must hold a current Assessment Practising Certificate (APC) for the assessment of specific learning difficulties. The APC must be current and will have been issued by a relevant professional association, (BDA, Dyslexia Guild or PATOSS).

An APC recognises professional achievement at postgraduate level as well as a commitment to continuing professional development (CPD). An APC must be renewed on a regular basis and demonstrates a commitment to the regular updating of professional skills and competence through study, professional training and practice.

Guidance on Continuing Professional Development for an APC

Continuing Professional Development (CPD) is an essential requirement for professionals to maintain and extend their professional knowledge and skills. The CPD undertaken for APC renewal helps professionals to keep abreast of current research fields, changes in practice and new developments. SASC issues regular guidance to encourage the development of assessment and reporting skills and provides listings of approved CPD courses.

To count towards meeting APC requirements, CPD activities should be at an appropriate level and contribute to an SpLD assessor's general professional skill and knowledge. Full details of requirements and the range of CPD activities that could contribute to a relevant CPD log can be found in SASC Guidelines on Continuing Professional Development.
